

MINUTES OF APRIL 3 MONTHLY MEETING OF BRIAR CHAPEL GARDEN CLUB

After due notice, the regular monthly meeting of the Briar Chapel Garden Club took place in the BC clubhouse on April 3, 2017. Those attending signed in. After a brief social period with snacks and wine, John Lunsford, elected President, called the meeting to order.

Two matters were brought up for further discussion and votes; upon Motion and second, members unanimously approved funding the Briar Chapel Garden Club website for another year. Upon Motion and second and following a discussion, members unanimously approved the passage of By-Laws to formally organize the Group and provide a structure for future years.
